### LACONIC LIVING TREASURE OF BLUES, RAGTIME, AND OLD-TIMEY MUSIC

"The Book" is the epitome of the singing, song writing, storytelling Bluesman troubadour. From the early sixties he became a student and friend of the Rev. Gary Davis and it was from these early days he became equally at home with Blues and Ragtime. He is known to shift from open tunings to slide arrangements set to his original and sometimes quirky tongue in cheek compositions, with both traditional and self-styled licks, drawing on many musical influences.

He also combines his Blues with Hokum, Dixie Jazz licks, Yas Yas styling's, recited lines, Old Timey acoustic Hill Country music with ease. It is this storey telling style that he is renowned for. Roy is much revered and has shared the stage with a luminary of some of the biggest Roots artists around the world. He also is a guitar teacher of note and most of his compositions relate back to his time as chauffeur and companion to Rev. Gary Davis. With his latest release "The Book" once again delivers just what he does best. ""The Good Book"" on his own label, Peg Leg Records, presents 10 quality self penned compositions all delivered in his laconic style.
